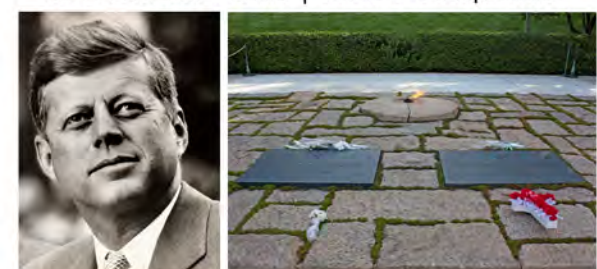

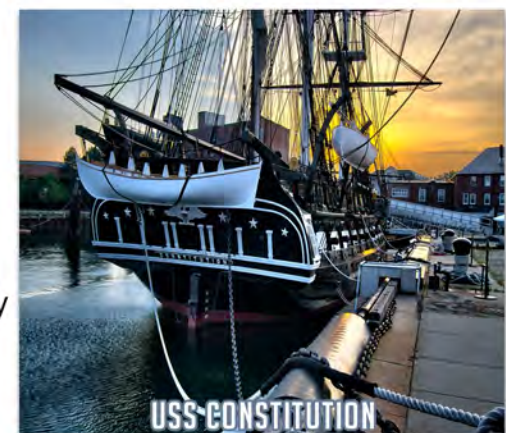

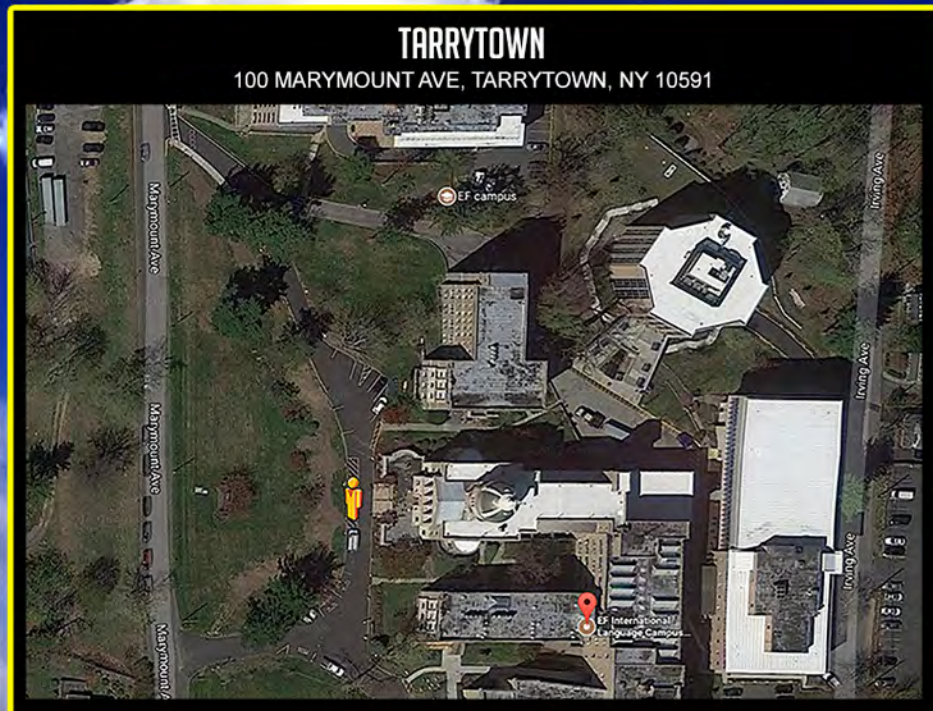

# Expedition America Cancellation Policy

## No cancellations, refunds, or switching tours.

**1. All Sales Are Final** - Before you pay & sign up for any tour make sure that you are 100% sure that you want to go. There will be no refunds to people who pay and then decide later that they do not wish to go.

**2. Do Not Be Late** - Make sure that you arrive early to your pickup location. Buses will depart at the scheduled pickup times and will not wait for people. If you are late and get left behind you will NOT receive a refund for your trip. It is your responsibility to make sure that you arrange for transportation to and from the pickup location and that you are either early or on time to the pickup.

**3. No Switches** - Make sure that you sign up for the tour that you want to go on. There will be no switches after you have signed up for a tour.

## Room Occupancy Guide - Overnight & Weekend Trips

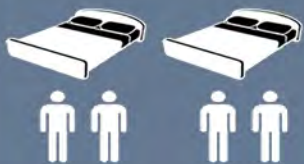
**Quad** - 4 people in a room with 2 beds (guests will share beds)

**Single** - 1 person will have their own room with 2 beds

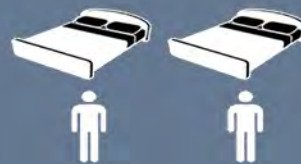

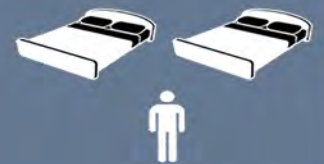
